## THE BIBLE TIMELINE

### SESSION 13: DIVIDED KINGDOM-PART 1

This week *The Bible Timeline* continues its study of the First Book of Kings. Solomon assumes the throne of Israel after the death of his father David. God invites King Solomon to ask for anything he wants. Rather than ask for wealth or long life, he asks God for "an understanding mind to govern ... that I may discern between good and evil" (1 Kings 3:9). God grants Solomon not only the wisdom he requests but also the things he does not ask for—riches and honor. God promises Solomon a long life if he will follow God's commands and walk in His ways. Solomon builds a magnificent temple as a permanent place for God to dwell among His people. This class will meet on Thursday, February 11th at 1:00 PM and again at 7:00 PM in the Parish Hall.
