### THE BIBLE TIMELINE

#### SESSION 17: MACCABEAN REVOLT

This week's session introduces the First Book of Maccabees. This book tells the story of Antiochus Epiphanes and his suppression of the Jews and desecration of the Temple. Israel is divided into those who abandon the Law and join in sacrilege, and those who love God's law and are driven into hiding to escape death. A man named Mattathias refuses to forsake the Covenant or God's commands. He and his five sons stand as models of faith and courage. The Second Book of Maccabees tells the story of a mother and her seven sons, all who suffered martyrdom for remaining steadfast in their faith. This class will meet March 11th at 1:00 PM and 7:00 PM in the Parish Hall.
