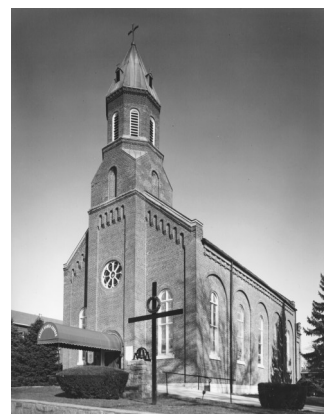

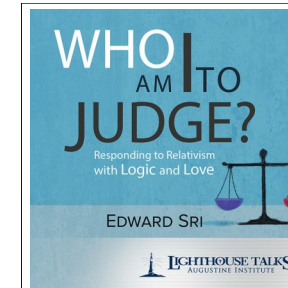

It is absolutely more powerful when someone prays and fasts for another instead of just talking to that other person every now and then.
