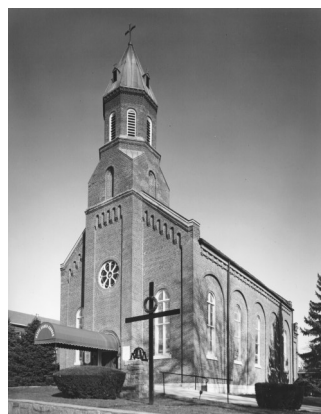

## Adoration on Holy Thursday Night.

The night Mass Commemorates the Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper, and the Institution of the Priesthood. Afterwards a procession thru the church aisles leads the Blessed Sacrament to be reposed in a side shrine. The tabernacle is left open and empty, the altar and sanctuary are stripped bare. **All worshippers leave the church in silence.** Parishioners are asked to make a "holy hour" of prayer and presence before the Blessed Sacrament. The parish church will remain open for silent adoration and prayer until Midnight on Holy Thursday. To ensuring that someone will be present before the Blessed Sacrament at all times. A sign-up sheet is available on a table at the entrance of church, to accept volunteers for the various time slots. Naturally, you are welcome to make adoration vigil that best suits your schedule and available time.
