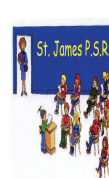

*"Do This in Memory of Me."*

When Christ spoke these words at the Last Supper he was asking his disciples not to look back, but to look forward. In recalling the past, doing what he commanded "in memory of Me," Christ was inviting them to anticipate the future. The recalling becomes an expectation of eternal life. Looking forward, not back. In today's first reading the Apostles stand accused: "Yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching" (Acts 5:28). Filled with the Holy Spirit, emboldened with the Eucharist, the followers of Christ in the Acts of the Apostles were looking forward, anticipating-as John relates in Revelations-"power and riches, wisdom and strength, honor and glory and blessing" (Rev. 5: 12). We seek to gather the entire Catholic community as one through the Annual Catholic Appeal. Each year we are united as one in this Appeal, recognizing God's blessings in our lives, anticipating eternal life, offering our gifts as followers of Jesus, working together for the salvation of the world.
