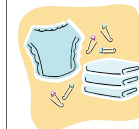
GOLF TOURNAMENT

Mr. Rosemond Steib, father of Bishop J. Terry Steib, S.V.D. of Memphis, Tennessee died on Friday, May 7, 2010.. Mr. Steib, 94 years old, was born 1919 in Vacherie, Louisiana. The Mass of Christian Burial was held May 11th, at Our Lady of Peace Church in Vacherie where Mr. Steib was a life-long member. May he rest in peace.

Bishop J. Terry Steib was ordained Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of St. Louis on February 10, 1984 by then Archbishop John L. May. He was the first black priest to serve as an auxiliary bishop in this archdiocese. Bishop Steib served the Archdiocese of St. Louis until he was installed as Bishop of the diocese of Memphis on May 5, 1993. He is a member of the Divine Word Missionaries (SVD).
