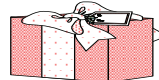

After the Mass, anyone who was available to do so, was invited to join the pastor for breakfast at the Family Steakhouse here in Potosi. Some 25 persons were able to do so. Fr. Joe wishes to thank those parishioners who sent cards, prayers and your good wishes to him on this milestone. “Ad Multos Annos, Fr. Joe” !

Archdiocese Staff Move

The St. Louis Archdiocese has moved most of the staff, including the Offices of the Archbishop, Bishop, Vicar General, Metropolitan Tribunal, Chancellors and Pastoral Planning to the Cardinal Regale Center in Shrewsbury, St. Louis County. This center was prior to 1988, the former freestanding “Kenrick Seminary” building on Laclede Station Rd. In order to focus more on the mission of Catholic Education, we have moved the Catholic Education Office to the Catholic Center (round building, formerly known as the chan-cery), in the Central West End of St Louis City. The archbishop will maintain offices in both buildings.

Happy Birthday, **Msgr. James E. Hanson**, native of St. Joachim Parish, Old Mines. Msgr. Hanson noted his 75th birthday on Thursday, May 27, 1935. He is the pastor at St. Joseph Church, Zell, in St. Genevieve County, MO. “Ad Multos Annos” (Many More Good YEARS) is a Latin expression used in greeting a priest on his birthday or anniversary. Msgr. Hanson is a brother to Benedict “Benny” Hanson who lives here in Washington County.

I, Fr. Joe Welschmeyer, your pastor, was away from the parish from May 11-22. I attended the Passion Play at **Oberammergau**, Bavaria, Germany. I also visited sites in the Tyrolean Alps around Berchtesgaden (the garden of the mountains); and Fussen, Bavaria, Germany. Though I speak German, the Barische dialect has its own world. These towns border on Salzburg, Austria; Switzerland and Italy.

On Sunday May 15th, our group bus stopped at a small Bavarian village of “Markl am Inn” (market on the Inn River). This is where our present Pope Benedict XVI was born in April 1927. His father was a village policeman of modest income. The former family home stands as it did when he was born there. The parish church of St. Oswald stands nearby, where Joseph Ratsinger was baptized, and attended Mass with his family as a child.

Some priests share nothing of their trips with their faithful. Others can be overbearing. I will try to find some balance in sharing this pilgrimage trip with you. Next week, I’ll have some “high points” on an insert in the weekend bulletin.

I would like to thank Fr. Richard Tillman and Fr. Joseph Danielson CSSR for filling in for me here at St. James, while I was away. Thank you to all who keep the parish going while I was away.
