Note: On June 11th, the Year of the Priest concluded in St. Peter's Square in Vatican City, Rome, Europe. There were 15,000 priests from all over the world who celebrated the outdoor Mass in St. Peter's Square, with Pope Benedict XVI as the presiding "priest". 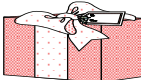
