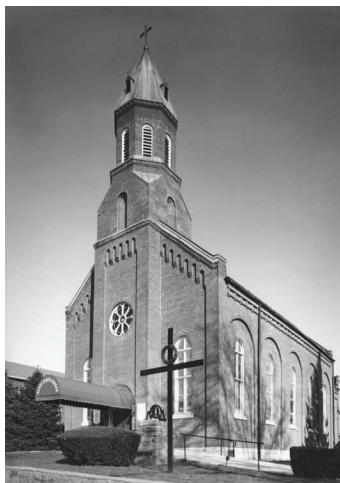

Sisters and brothers of our parish family. Your pastor, Fr. Joe is glad to be back home here at St. James in Potosi. I left here on June 4th for the medical surgery. I then convalesced at a Catholic nursing home in the metro St. Louis area. The R.N.'s and the dieticians were a great help for me. I returned here to the parish on Sunday June 21st, the first day of summer. This means I spent the month of June "very quietly", but it was for healing and for prayer. I was able to reflect on various matters of my life, my hopes, my dreams, new insights. These are matters that the parish responsibilities never allow me time to participate in.

Because I was not on "vacation", I held fast to my obligation to pray for the people of St. James Parish; and for the members of my own Welschmeyer family. It was "odd" celebrating Mass alone, in a small room set aside for this at the nursing home. Each night I was able to commend each of you, your families and your spiritual and physical health to the love and protection of Our Lord, and his mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Thank you one and each, for your **concern, prayers, cards, notes** and your **verbal** good wishes for my recovery and for the settling of my health issues. It was necessary that I returned to St. Louis University Medical School during this past week. There in the dermatology clinic, I underwent "Mohs Surgery" on the crown of my head for basal cell carcinoma (skin cancer). This is distinct from the other melanoma issues I dealt with in the surgery of June 5th. Your children may ask, "Why did Fr Joe have bandages on his head?" You will be able to give them an open, honest answer.

Thank you for your attendance and good spirit shown to Bishop Casey, following last weekends Masses. A special thanks to the Ladies that prepared the reception.

It is good to be home again, leading you in prayer and sacrament, as your priest. It is no secret on my part, I love St. James Parish and her people.
