### "Young People"

#### Parish Membership here at St. James Parish

Once a Catholic person is 21 years of age, and is a wage earner, you are expected to register yourself in any Catholic parish office. This means you register, where you live in the boundaries of the parish where you reside. Whether you are living on your own, or in your family home, the Catholic Church requires you to register as a member of a particular parish.

As a child, your parents have a moral responsibility, dating from your baptism, to see that you are given religious instruction. This instruction is often done in a "parish school of religion" program or in a Catholic School. One is trained to receive one's First Reconciliation, First Communion (age 7); and later, your Confirmation around the age of 14 years.

When you register as a young adult, you are taking responsibility for "living out your own Catholic faith." It is meaningless to come to a parish many years later and say, "Well my parents belonged to this parish." After the age of 21, you cannot possibly pretend to live on the faith of your parents. Allow your Catholic faith, to be your lived Catholic faith in your life.

#### Taking Communion at Non-Catholic Churches

*Q. If I have been baptized in the Catholic Church, is it permissible for me to participate in the holy Communion at another Christian Church?*

**A.** The answer is no. The reason is this. The Church teaches that to partake of Communion in any Christian tradition is publicly to declare one is in full agreement with what that tradition teaches or holds. Therefore, if you, a Catholic, were to share in the Communion of a non-Catholic tradition, your action would bespeak a falsehood. For the same reason the Catholic Church does not allow non-Catholics to receive the Body and Blood of Our Lord in the Eucharist. This prohibition has nothing to do with the spiritual state of non-Catholics. In fact the rule exists for the protection of the integrity of non-Catholics who happen to be present at our Mass, the Eucharistic celebration. It prevents non-Catholics from unwittingly, but still symbolically, making a public statement that is not something they believe.
