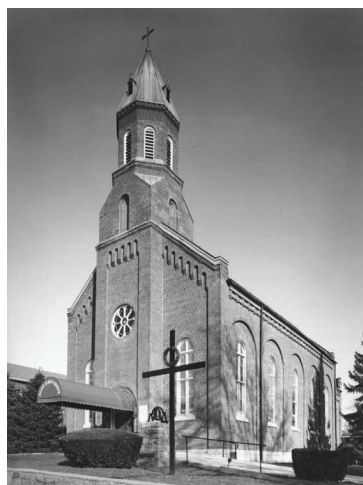

First Priest-Chaplain Dies from Wounds in Iraq

Fr. Tim Vakoc, 49, a military chaplain died June 20, 2009, of war wounds received in Mosul, Iraq, in May of 2004. He was returning to base at that time, after celebrating Mass with outlying American troops. After being cared for at several Veterans Hospitals before being cared for the past few years at a nursing home in Minnesota. A priest of the Archdiocese of Minneapolis-St. Paul, he joined the military chaplaincy in 1996. He shipped out to Iraq in 2004, as a chaplain in the Military Archdiocese of the United States. Following his Funeral Mass at the St. Paul Cathedral in St. Paul, MN. he was buried in the Ft. Snelling National Cemetery.
