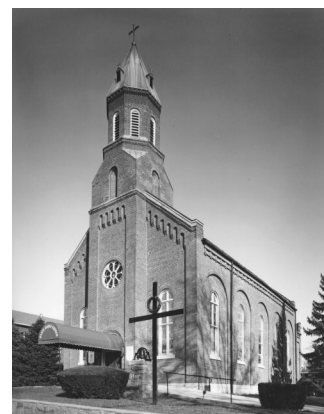

RCIA This Fall

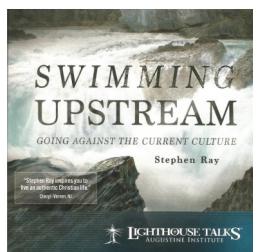
