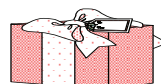

NEW DEAN OF FESTUS DEANERY

A new dean has been appointed as the dean of the Festus Deanery. Archbishop Robert J. Carlson has appointed **Fr. Patrick J. Christopher**, pastor of Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish at House Springs, Mo. as our new dean. This appointment was effective August 1st. In our Catholic vocabulary, a "deanery" is a organizational unit of parishes and missions. A deanery is made up of parishes in counties, and a region. A deanery is more than one parish, but it is not a total diocese. A dean is appointed by the residential bishop or archbishop in a diocese. St. James Parish, Potosi, and the other two parishes in Washington County, (St. Stephen's, Richwoods; and St. Joachim Old Mines/ Cadet, are also part of the Festus Deanery.

The other parishes in our deanery include: Assumption of the Blessed Mary-Herculaneum; Church of the Good Shepherd-Hillsboro; Immaculate Conception-Arnold; Our Lady, Queen of Peace-House Springs; Our Lady-Festus; Sacred Heart-Crystal City; St. Anthony-High Ridge; St. David-Arnold; St. John-Imperial; St. Joseph-Imperial; and St. Rose of Lima-DeSoto.

The next parish west Steelville is in the Diocese of Jefferson city. The next parish south of us, Ste. Marie du Lac, Ironton, is in the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. The parishes east of us, in St. Francois County, are in the St. Genevieve Deanery of the St. Louis Archdiocese. When a person has a Catholic vocabulary, it gives a person a deeper sense that our Catholic faith is **here** and **now** in the lands were we live, work and find meaning in God's sustaining our lives.
