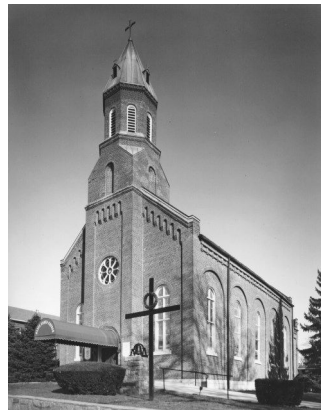

Parish School of Religion will begin on Wednesday, **September 6h** starting at 6:30pm with Open House and Registration. All students and at least one parent are required to attend!

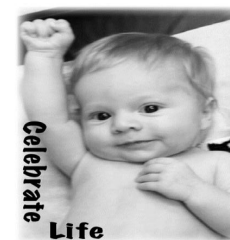
## EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

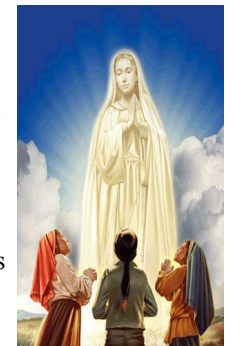
## CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

### The Desire for God

"Let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice."<sup>5</sup> Although man can forget God or reject him, He never ceases to call every man to seek him, so as to find life and happiness. But this search for God demands of man every effort of intellect, a sound will, "an upright heart", as well as the witness of others who teach him to seek God.

You are great, O Lord, and greatly to be praised: great is your power and your wisdom is without measure. and man, so small a part of your creation, wants to praise you: this man, though clothed with mortality and bearing the evidence of sin and the proof that you withstand the proud. Despite everything, man, though but a small a part of your creation, wants to praise you. You yourself encourage him to delight in your praise, for you have made us for yourself, and our heart is restless until it rests in you.

One hundred years ago, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, entrusting them with a message for the whole world. She taught them that peace in the world can only be the fruit of personal conversion through penance and prayer. Peace also requires the praying of the Holy Rosary.



On **Wednesday, September 13**, Saint Joseph's church in Bonne Terre will be blessed by the visit of a pilgrim statue of Our Lady of Fatima. It will be in the church for the 8 AM Mass and will remain throughout the day for public veneration until 4 PM. The Rosary will be prayed at noon. The visit of the pilgrim statue also affords us the opportunity to gain a special plenary indulgence granted by Pope Francis during the Fatima anniversary year. To gain the indulgence you must visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration on the 13th of any month between May and October 2017 and there devoutly participate in some celebration in honor of the Virgin Mary. The Rosary will fulfill that obligation. The usual conditions for a plenary indulgence also apply: sacramental confession, Holy Communion, prayers for the intention of the Holy Father and detachment from sin, even venial sin.
