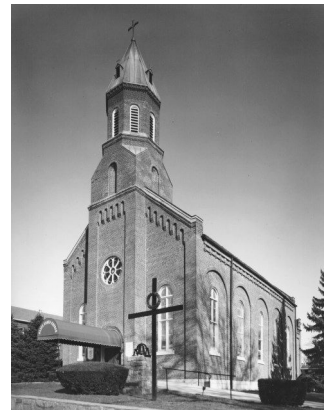

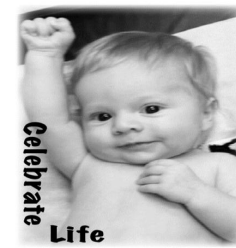
Children's Liturgy of the Word

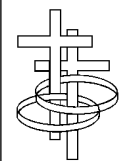
FOOD DRIVE

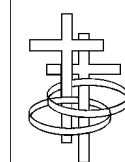
VAN DRIVERS NEEDED!
