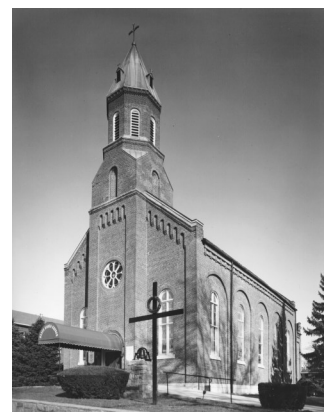

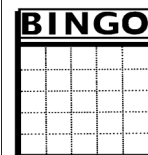

Dear Friends in Christ,

The annual celebration of World Mission Sunday on the next-to-last Sunday in October provides us, as members of the Body of Christ, an opportunity to show our solidarity with one another. In his 2017 message for World Mission Sunday, Pope Francis invites us "to reflect anew on the *mission at the heart of the Christian faith*." As we know, mission is not an optional aspect of our vocation as baptized Christians; rather, sharing the gift of divine life and love received in Baptism is an imperative received from Christ.

Laity, Religious, and clergy alike strive to make "present in history the *Kairos*, the favorable time of salvation" in the more than 1,100 local churches throughout the world that the Pope's Mission Societies support.
